DAY 1

When everyone arrives we will meet in the House for Tea, Coffee and introductions. We'll then head to the Barn to begin preparing the armature and making the Deers supporting structure, which we will fill out over the course of the day building in the basis for the deers form.

DAY2

Having laid all the foundations on day 1 day two will be spent focusing on finishing forming the deers head, ears and antlers ('if you want them) and then finishing the surface and infilling on the body and final details like the tail.

WILLOW SCULPTURE

Description and Preparation

Willow sculpture workshops at Lydford House are a relaxed and creative experience, you will spend two days outside, (weather dependant) surrounded by views of devon country side and Dartmoor, learning how to sculpt with willow. We will cover how to make the armature structure and what to use to support the Deer while you work, making the skeletal structure and how to fill it in and finally refining the surface of the deer by creating the impression of muscle and realistic form.

You do not need to bring any equipment or materials for the workshop.

Through out the workshop we will draw information from the deers form itself, looking at its natural characteristics to ensure your sculpture looks realistic and in proportion.


In order to achieve this I ask that you do a little homework in preparation by researching images of deer, and do some basic sketches of the shapes that create the deers over all form.

Please bring these images and sketches to the workshop. This will help you in the workshop giving you a collection of images and shapes to use as reference when building your deers inner structure, and when shaping the outer form.

These workshops are challenging and requires stamina, you will be manipulating the willow, which can be tough on your fingers and hands.

However they are suitable for anyone from complete beginners, to those who may be more skilled.

The workshop is a great way to get to grips with willow work and you get to take home your fantastic sculpture at the end!

Food & Drink
